

# Lesson Three

## What Does the Bible Teach About God?

*(The answer is everything we know to be true about God. There is not other reliable source that reveals who God is and what He has done.)*

1. What is God?

John 4:24 God is Spirit What does this mean? (or what are the implications of this truth?) It means a number of things. He is not visible (material); He is not bound by time. He is not bound by Space.

2. What is God like? (... and why is this a good this to know as opposed to being afraid?)

Psalms 90:1, 2 God is everlasting: Infinite (not simply eternal) Why is this good to know?

Malachi 3:6 God is unchangeable – immutable. Why is this good to know?

Genesis 17:1 God is almighty – (omnipotent) Why is this good to know?

Psalms 139:1-4 God is all knowing (omniscient) Why is this good to know?

Jeremiah 23:24 God is everywhere: (omnipresent) Why is this good to know?

Leviticus 19:2 God is Holy, Set Apart, What is significant about this?

Deuteronomy 32:4 God is Just, Faithful, perfect, “Solid” in integrity.

2 Timothy 2:13 God is Faithful, loyal

Psalms 145:9 God is compassionate, merciful to all not just to some.

1 John 4:8 God is love (agape) Unconditional

3. Who is the only true God?

Deuteronomy 6:4 The Lord, the Living God, He is One – In Entity

Matthew 28:19 He is also Trinity – three persons in one Entity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. This economy is indicated throughout the Scriptures.

4. What does it mean "to believe in God?"

John 17:3 it means eternal life – and it means we know God.

John 17:17 it means to study God’s Word, Sanctified, prepared to act, not simply to react. To know the truth

Psalms 31:14 It means to trust in God above all things
