The Creeds and the Confessions

Our Lutheran Church has nine creeds and confessions in which we state what we believe.

The Ecumenical (or Universal) Creeds are:

- 1. The Apostles' Creed.
- 2. The Nicene Creed.
- 3. The Athanasian Creed.

The Confessions of the Evangelical Lutheran Church are:

- 1. The Augsburg Confession.
- 2. The Apology of the Augsburg Confession.
- 3. The Smalcald Articles.
- 4. The Small Catechism of Luther.
- 5. The Large Catechism of Luther.
- 6. The Formula of Concord.

These six Confessions and the Ecumenical Creeds form the <u>Book of Concord</u> which was first published in 1580. A more recent edition is available for purchase from any bookstore upon request. If you wish to order a copy ask for <u>The Book of Concord</u>, the Tappert edition, published by Fortress Press. You may also ask the church office to assist you.

The Church Year

The church year has been arranged to set before us the principal events in the Savior's life. Notice that the first half addresses Jesus, His ministry and His work for all mankind. The second half of the year highlights His bride the church and the response she is called to because of His death and resurrection.

You will notice festivals listed below which some congregations include and others do not include. Variations are acceptable because of the Lord's teaching that the Sabbath was made for man and that man was not made for the Sabbath.

The historic order is as follows:

Four Sundays in Advent.

Christmas.

Festival of Circumcision (January 1).

Epiphany (January)

From one to six Sundays after Epiphany (depending on the date of Easter).

Three Sundays before Lent: Septuagesima, Sexagesima, Quinquagesima.

Ash Wednesday (beginning of Lent).

Six Sundays in Lent (the sixth being Palm Sunday).

Holy Week, the week before Easter (including Holy Thursday, or Maundy Thursday, and Good Friday).

Easter

Five Sundays after Easter

Ascension Day (40 days after Easter).

Sunday after Ascension

Pentecost, or Whitsunday (50 days after Easter).

Trinity Sunday (and from 22 to 27 Sundays after Trinity).

The Lutheran Church typically observes the Festival of the Reformation on or around October 31.

A Short Form for Holy Baptism in Cases of Emergency

In urgent cases and in the absence of the pastor, any Christian may administer Holy Baptism.

Take water, call the child by name, pour or sprinkle the water on the head of the child, saying:

I baptize you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

If there is time, the baptism may be preceded by the following prayer and the Lord's Prayer:

Eternal, merciful God, we pray that You extend Your goodness and mercy to this child, who now asks; open the door to him/her who knocks, that he/she may enjoy the everlasting blessing of Your heavenly washing and may come to the eternal kingdom which You have prepared through Christ, our Lord. Amen.

Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven; Give us this day our daily bread; And forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who sin against us; And lead us not into temptation; But deliver us from evil; For Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.
