## Lesson 2: Growing Up in Christ

Our world today likes instant solutions and quick answers for people's needs: Instant foods, rapidly working miracle drugs, instant electronic communications. A half hour T.V. program will create a problem, explore the problem and then solve the problem with ten minutes worth of commercials. As Christians we must remember that there is no such thing as "instant maturity" in the Christian life. Growth in the things of the Lord takes time and hard work. Becoming a Christian begins a lifelong adventure of knowing God better, loving Him more, and growing closer to Him.

SUMMARY: A CHRISTIAN'S SALVATION HAS THREE ASPECTS.  It is important to understand each one.	
Justification Past event-You have been saved from the penalty and guilt of sin.  Your Position before God is perfect and right through Christ.	
Sanctification Present action-You are being saved from the power of sin.  Your Condition is that you are becoming Christ-like through God's power.	
Glorification Future Event-You will be saved from the presence of sin.  Your Expectation is to be released from all evil and live in God's pure glory.	

God's work of salvation continues in you all your life. He wants us to grow spiritually all of our lives. How do you grow in the faith? The Bible says that in order to grow spiritually, we must grow in the following ways:

- 1) Growth in the study and use of God's Word;
- 2) Growth in participation and dedication to our spiritual family;

- 5) Growth in witnessing;
- 6) Growth in obedience.

This discipleship class will help you grow in all of these areas. It will take you into the solid food God wants to give to all living and growing Christians.
