The use and honor of the name of Jesus were important to the New Testament churches.

The use of His name demonstrates the centrality of Christ in the New Testament era.
When you prepare to make a request in Jesus' name, ask yourself first: "What would Jesus want in this situation?"
What is accomplished by answering this question?
What problem is raised by this question?
Luke 11
2 Thessalonians 1:11-12. Pray this prayer of Paul's for a Christian friend. In place of the pronoun "you," name your friend. Remember that you want Jesus to be glorified in what occurs in your friend's life. Pray it again for another person.
Do Not Use Jesus' Name Carelessly
Using Jesus' name is not ritual with magical results. It reflects your taking Jesus' character and demands integrity.
2 Kings 5:20-27 Acts 19:13-17
The use of Jesus' name is especially serious. When you use it, you are representing Jesus, His kingdom, and His character. That name stands for the person, and the use of a name involves all that the person stands for. You must not use Jesus' name carelessly.
