things. He prayed for great and sweeping issues.	

Personal Prayer Requests

You should petition God for our own personal needs. Jesus taught this to His disciples. In the

Model Prayer, after the prayer for God's honor and kingdom, Jesus authorized a series of personal requests:
a) daily bread
b) for forgiveness of sin
c) for deliverance from temptation
These indicate three large areas God is interested in (to understanding).
Ask for Guidance
Jesus asked for guidance.

Mark 1:35-39
